What is the Guttenberg Library Foundation?

The Guttenberg Library Foundation was formed in 2012 by a group of community - minded citizens working to support the library by organizing events and projects to raise funds and advocate for the library. The Foundation is an IRS 501 (c) (3) charitable organization with all the funds dedicated to the library. The Foundation is a separate organization that is an affiliate of the library.

Why is the Foundation needed?

The Guttenberg Public Library as a taxsupported institution faces challenges in
raising the needed funds to supply an
increasing demand for library services. Often
tax revenues are insufficient to keep our
books, CD's, DVD's, services, programs, and
facilities up to the level required by our
community. The Foundation raises money for
projects that could not be funded out of tax
dollars. By raising private dollars we are able
to leverage and stretch our public dollars.
Donors who have a strong belief that the
Library changes lives can contribute to the
library through the Foundation as a non-profit
tax-exempt organization.

How can I make a contribution?

Gifts to the Foundation can be made in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to:

· Foundation Fund

Consider making an annual gift to the foundation fund. Interest from this fund is used to enhance the library's collections and services today and in the future.

Planned Giving

Remembering the library in your will with a bequest, trust, gift of stock, securities, or property can benefit the entire community, as well as your tax position.

· Lifetime Gifts

Gift instruments such as charitable remainder trusts can benefit both the donor and the library during the donor's lifetime.

Designated Gifts

Gifts provide important needed items that are not within the library budget.
