Budget – Leaving the budget as planned, with the 3% wage increase. Katie will have it all submitted to city by end of the week, for the December workshop meeting. Hansel making the motion to go ahead with the planned budget for 2020/2021 and Mast second the motion. The motion was carried.

CCLA 2020 Fall Meeting – Katie stated the meeting went well. Nothing new came out of it. Elkader Library is open by appointments only and on Saturdays is curbside pick-up only. All other libraries in the area are open, as of now.

Correspondence – Thank you note from Katie Beitzel, thanking the board members and staff for the beautiful gift in memory of her mother.

Webinar – Library staff member Nancy came across a webinar with a site for programs with ideas for crafts, snacks, activities, etc.... The program for a whole year is \$500. Jim stated the Foundation is in the process right now of voting on and approving funding for the \$500. If it would be approved the library would post these ideas and use these programs on the library's website and Facebook page.

Foundation Report – September's Meeting elected officers.

Approve Bills - Initialed and approved by board members; Jim and Dana.
